**1. QUESTION:** Section C, paragraph 1.0 – The statement of scope for this contract is very broad, encompassing technical support, inspection, test and verification as well as other technical and programmatic support. In the opinion of the U.S. Army Engineering Support Center, could a prime contractor or subcontractor's participation in a task order under this contract create a conflict of interest if the company was also a party to one of the Center's installation contracts (i.e. the ESS, UMCS, or IR contracts)?

**ANSWER:** Yes, there would be a potential conflict of interest.

**2. QUESTION:** Section L – Neither the SF 33 nor Section L delineate the Proposal Due date/time/place. Please clarify the due date and provide a valid address for proposal submission.

**ANSWER:** The closing date and time is 9 January 2004, 2:00 p.m., local time. This was incorporated into Amendment 0001.

**3. QUESTION:** Section L.2.1 – There is a conflict between this section's description of the volumes making up the proposal and the description contained in Section L.3. Please clarify which proposal format is required.
