


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Summary of Anticipated Work

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OBJECTIVE



The objective of this Multiple Award Task Order Contract (MATOC) is for Contractors to perform Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP) responses involving conventional munitions and Recovered Chemical Warfare Materiel (RCWM); Environmental Compliance and Remediation Services (E CRS); and Other Munitions-Related Services (OMRS), as necessary to permit lands and waters to be safely and efficiently used for their intended purpose.




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LOCATION



This work may occur at sites located in the lands and waters of Continental United States (CONUS) and Outside Continental United States (OCONUS), including support to the US Army munition clearance missions in Iraq, Afghanistan, and other locations. In addition, MMRP, HTRW, and OMRS for foreign governments/agencies, where sponsored by an appropriate US Government Agency, may be required under this contract.



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ANTICIPATED WORK

(1 of 2)



Work performed under this contract may include MMRP, HTRW and/or Munitions and Explosives of Concern (MEC) assessments; inspections; investigations; studies, engineering evaluations; cost analyses; remedial or removal actions; recovery, storage, and disposal of HTRW, MEC and/or contaminated media; monitoring; data management; training; logistical; medical; and security support.

(2 of 2)



In addition, for OMRS the work may also include construction support, range clearance, ammunition depot management, post-battlefield munitions clearance, demining operations, booby trap clearances, and disablement and cleanup of unconventional warfare explosive devices.



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

Final list of “Key Personnel” has not yet been determined, but is likely to include most or all of the following:




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Program Manager



- The person with corporate responsibility for the contract
- POC for the Contracting Officer
- Provides programmatic reporting to the CO
- Can address overall management and contracting issues



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Corporate Quality Manager



- The person who assures overall quality of contract deliverables and general contract compliance
- Documented education, training and experience in Quality Management



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Corporate Health and Safety Officer



- The person who assures overall health and safety
- Meets OPM Standard for Safety and Occupational Health Specialist or Safety Engineer
- Board Certified Safety Professional or Registered Professional Engineer
- Minimum 5 years directly related experience




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Project Manager



- The person with overall responsibility for performance of individual task orders
- Documented education, training and experience in Project Management
- Minimum 3 years directly related experience



Senior UXO Supervisor

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- Meets the qualifications and performs the functions as described in TP-18



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Senior Geophysicist



- The person with overall responsibility for design, implementation, and management of all geophysical investigations.
- Documented education, training and experience in geophysics
- Minimum of 5 years directly related experience




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Program Property Manager



- The person responsible for accountability and control of Government-furnished property and equipment.
- Documented skills, training, and experience.
