3. **SITE DESCRIPTION:** Malden Army Airfield consists of approximately 2,910.81 acres. The airfield is currently used primarily as an airport and an industrial park. The entire site is owned by the City of Malden, which leases portions of the site to raise revenue for the airport.

4. SITE HISTORY: The Army Air Corps used the site for basic flight training from the early 1940s until 1948. In 1948, the entire site was disposed of to the City of Malden. Malden Army Airfield was reactivated in 1951 as Malden Air Base by the Air Force to provide basic flight training. However, it was then a civilian contract air base operated by Anderson Air Activities of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Malden Air Base closed in 1960 and the site reverted back to the City of Malden. No aerial gunnery or bombing was performed at the site. However, an ordnance storage area, a pistol/skeet range area and a gas chamber area existed at the site. There have been no reported incidents involving ordnance and explosives (OE) at the site.

b. The deed conveying this site to the City of Malden, MO, restricting use to a public airport/Industrial Park, had no restoration provision and contained a recapture clause.
