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3. SITE DESCRIPTION: The former William's Field Bomb Target Range #7 is located approximately 9 miles southeast of Florence, AZ in Pinal County. The site consisted of 976.24 acres. The site and surrounding areas are flat desert land and currently used for cattle grazing.

4. SITE HISTORY: There is no acquisition or disposal information available for this site. The site was used for bombing training by crews from Williams AAF in Higley, AZ. The only improvements to this site consisted of the construction of aiming circles. The aiming circles are still visible. There is a large amount of M38A2, 100 lb. Practice Bomb debris at the center of the target and scattered around the area. A mounting ring from an M8A1, Parachute Flare and a small six-pointed object (probably a sub-munition from a clam shell type bomb) were also found on site. There was no evidence found to indicate that HE bombing activity or Chemical Warfare Materials usage ever occurred on this site.

presence, absence or location of listed species or natural communities.

c. A 4-W-D vehicle is recommended for travel to this site.
