EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1. The objective of this contract is risk reduction/cleanup of Ordnance and Explosives (OE) at Fort McClellan, Alabama, using innovative technologies and applications which provide improved quality and productivity at reduced cost. This is a one-time pilot engineering and technological holistic approach to OE risk reduction/cleanup. Fort McClellan is a U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command Facility and is scheduled to close in September 1999 under the Base Realignment and Closure Act (BRAC). OE is a safety hazard and may constitute an imminent and substantial danger to site personnel and the local populace. Innovative technologies/approaches proposed must be mature enough for application in a field production environment. The Government intends to award a contract based upon that information contained in the offeror's initial proposal (without discussions), circumstances permitting. This requirement will be competed on a full and open basis under the Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Code 8711.

2. Notwithstanding Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) clause 52.215-1(f)(6) (Section L), only one award will be made from this solicitation. The resultant contract awarded from this solicitation will constitute an Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity (ID,IQ) type contract as defined in FAR 16.504. Information in the Schedule of Section B, will provide for acquiring materials or services on the basis of reimbursement of materials and payment of labor at specified fixed burdened hourly rates which include wages, overhead, general and administrative expenses. Task orders may be: 1) Firm-Fixed Price (FFP) and/or 2) Time and Materials (T&M). It is anticipated that approximately 85 percent of the task order efforts will be firm-fixed price. However, task orders may be issued on a T&M basis for other incidental work of an indefinite nature or to support an urgent need. Individual task orders may contain a combination of FFP and T&M, e.g. planning and characterization may be FFP while data validation may be T&M. Award of task orders is non-protestable in accordance with FAR 16.505(a)(7). T&M orders may be unilaterally or bilaterally awarded; fixed price orders will be bilaterally agreed upon. This solicitation is for a one base year and four option years contract ordering period against which task orders will be issued for services as described in Section C.

3. The ordering period shall commence upon the date of award and shall continue for a period of five years. Labor rates may be escalated annually (but see FAR 52.222-43(b) for limitations) as provided in the Schedule; however, the labor rates in effect at the time an effort is awarded will remain in effect through completion of that awarded effort.

4. The Government is under no obligation to issue any orders against contracts resulting from this solicitation in excess of the minimum contract obligation. The estimated maximum contract amount is \$50,000,000 over a period of five years (one base year and 4 option years). The estimated annual usage is \$10,000,000. There is a minimum obligation of \$200,000 for the base year and \$100,000 for each option year exercised. In the event that the Government does not award an order(s) that satisfies the minimum obligation, the contractor will be entitled to, as an exclusive remedy, breach of contract damages, i.e., lost profits and any stand by costs.

5. The Government reserves the right to synopsise and award other contracts for similar work within the geographic area described in Section C prior to contract award or during contract performance of the resultant contract.

6. When request for proposals (RFPs) for task order requirements are issued, sufficient detail with regard to labor categories and hours, material, and travel must be provided by the offeror to allow an examination of the proposed cost.

7. For T&M orders, all hours for direct labor shall be supported by individual daily job cards or time records signed by the individual thereof.

8. The offeror receiving the award will be held to the terms of its proposed price when the Government issues the initial actual task order. The contract and initial actual task order will be issued concurrently. The initial actual task order will be issued as a combination firm-fixed price and T&M task order.

9. The only authorized ordering office is the U.S. Army Engineering and Support Center, Huntsville (USAESCH).

10. The unit prices of the offeror's proposal for both fixed-price and T&M will be used for all future task orders on this contract.
