

**H**untsville Center's Center of Standardization (COS) was established by the Director of Military Programs in March 2006 to be the Army's life cycle manager for assigned facility types. The COS supports the Army Corps of Engineers, the Installation Management Command (IMCOM) and the Office of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Installation Management (OACSIM).


## Facts

Huntsville Center COS support includes:

- Developing and maintaining the Army standard, standard design and standard criteria in consultation with IMCOM, Headquarters Department of the Army facility proponents, major commands and Headquarters, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
- Developing and maintaining Building Information Models (BIM).
- Providing design oversight and construction support to Districts involved in the construction of assigned facilities.



- Developing standard DD Forms 1391 for assigned facilities.
- Participating in charrettes to ensure consistent application of criteria and to validate scope.
- Establishing regional Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ), design-build/adapt-build contracts for assigned facility types.



## Benefits

Centers of Standardization are achieving the standardization objectives stated by the Vice Chief of the Staff of the Army and the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army (Installation and Housing) within current time and funding constraints. Facility standardization is a critical element for ensuring installations meet common expectations in the form of capabilities, capacities and throughput.
