Corps of Engineers hosts students for mock munitions search

HUNTSVILLE, Ala. — The U.S. Army Engineering and Support Center, Huntsville, had more than 200 11th-grade students simulate a military munitions search Sept. 26 on Redstone Arsenal.

Huntsville Center conducts this kind of work at formerly used defense sites across the country.

Students used the same equipment that Huntsville Center geophysicists use and searched for mock “potential hazards” that had been placed in advance by Corps of Engineers employees.

Students also learned about military munitions safety and what it takes to become an engineer.

This hands-on event was part of the 7th annual Adventures in Engineering Day, which gives area 11th-grade students the opportunity to interact with local engineering agencies.
