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Huntsville Center awards contracts valued at \$165 Million

Huntsville, Ala. — The U.S. Army Engineering and Support Center, Huntsville, awarded contracts with \$165 million shared-capacity Nov. 8 to six companies to provide Operations and Maintenance Engineering Enhancement (OMEE) services at ambulatory care facilities in the U.S.

The multiple-award task order, indefinite delivery, indefinite quantity service contracts share a program-based capacity and have a base period of one year and four one -year option periods for a total of five years.

This acquisition provides for operations and maintenance services under the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code 561210, Facilities Support Services, to preserve and maintain government medical and non-medical facilities. Although this acquisition applies to facilities worldwide, the primary focus will be medical facilities in the continental United States.

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
