Distinguished Civilians Honored

Three Huntsvillians were recently named Distinguished Civilian Employees by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Huntsville Center.

David C. Cassady, Jr., Michael M. Dembo, and Henry O. Everitt, were honored for the positive differences and lasting contributions they made while serving in a variety of important assignments during their tenure at the Corps of Engineers' Huntsville Center. Awards were presented by the Center's Commander, Colonel Harry L. Spear during the annual Engineer Day awards ceremony at Monte Sano State Park.

Everitt served at the Center from 1968 to 1994. During his tenure he was Chief of the Modification and Reports Branch, Chief of the Scheduling and Control Branch, Construction Division; Chief, Systems Engineering Division, Chief of the Engineering Division, and was Deputy Commander for Programs and Technical Management.

Dembo worked at the Center from 1968 to 1988 and served in various assignments including Chief of the Research and Development Branch of Systems Engineering; Chief of Civil Structures Division, Engineering Division; and as Assistant Chief of the Engineering Division.

Cassady held positions as Chief of the Estimating Section, Chief of the Engineering Support Branch, Assistant Chief of Engineering Division, and Chief of the Cost Engineering Division. He served at the Center from 1968 to 1992.

The Distinguished Civilian title honors civilian employees for their service to the Engineering and Support Center, Huntsville; the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers; and the U.S. Army.
