**Subject:** Interim Army Standards for Canopies at Army Installation Access Control Points (ACP)

**Applicability:** Directive

1. Reference DAIM Memorandum, 26 Feb 2004, SAB. The referenced memorandum ([http://www.hnd.usace.army.mil/techinfo/ECB/Interim\\_.pdf](http://www.hnd.usace.army.mil/techinfo/ECB/Interim_.pdf)) contains interim Army standards for canopies at Army installation access control points (ACP). These standards are effective immediately and are applicable for all construction of new or renovation of existing Army ACPs. These standards will be implemented in all active ACP projects regardless of the status of planning, design or construction.
2. Project delivery teams (PDT) will evaluate on-going projects and take the necessary actions, in coordination with installation partners, to implement these standards in all on-going ACP projects. If incorporation of these standards will cause a project to exceed statutory funding limits or cause a Congressional re-programming action, then the installation should notify HQ Installation Management Agency (IMA) POC, Mr. Donald LaRocque, through their IMA Region prior to incorporation of these interim standards.
3. The PDT will evaluate ACP projects that have completed construction and beneficial occupancy and prepare a recommendation for the installation to forward to HQ IMA for decision.
4. Waivers should be considered only if incorporation of the interim standards would cause a non-MILCON project to exceed the statutory limit for minor construction projects or the Congressional re-programming threshold for MILCON projects. Waiver requests will be forwarded to regional IMA offices for processing to the Office of the Assistant Chief of Staff, Installation Management, ATTN: DAIM-FD, for staffing to the Army Facilities Standardization Committee for approval/disapproval.
5. If incorporation of the interim standards requires additional funding, follow normal funding procedures and notifications for the various appropriations and projects.
