1. PURPOSE:


a. This interim guidance introduces the Draft Engineering Regulation (ER) 385-1-95, Safety and Health Requirements for Munitions and Explosives of Concern (MEC) Operations, dated 1 April 2006. This Draft ER contains updated guidance on safety and health requirements when conducting operations involving MEC. This document has been coordinated extensively within the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) but will not be finalized until Department of Army completes work on revisions to Army Regulation 385-10. Major impacts to this ER resulting from AR 385-10 are not anticipated. Pending final approval from Headquarters USACE, you are encouraged to use this draft ER as appropriate.

2. EFFECTIVE DATES: The information presented in this interim guidance can be used immediately. The interim guidance will remain in effect until Headquarters USACE publication of the final ER 385-1-95.
