Huntsville Center employees recognized with special cleanup awards

HUNTSVILLE, Ala. -- Carol Youkey, the chief of the Military Munitions Center of Expertise, at the U.S. Corps of Engineers Huntsville Center, and James Manthey, program manager, Military Munitions Center of Expertise, received Special Cleanup Awards Jan. 31, at the 2006 Army Environmental Cleanup Workshop Jan 31 – Feb. 2 in San Antonio, Texas.

The awards were presented by Addison D. Davis IV, the deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army, (Environmental, Safety and Occupational Health).
