Scrap broker helps get best price for recyclable steel for Lake City
ammo plant removal project

Huntsville Center's Facilities Reduction Program is always looking for new ways to lower costs to the customer while diverting the largest percentage of demolition debris from the landfill.

Removing an outdated building at the U.S. Army Lake City Ammunition Plant in Independence, Mo., presented both challenges.

Huntsville Center is working with the Installation, the Corps of Engineers' Kansas City District and Bhate Associates of Birmingham, Ala., to remove Bldg. 3A from the Lake City Army Ammunition Plant. Local fire departments have also helped with the project by keeping the building wet during certain phases of the demolition.
