Contractors share \$30 million award for services

HUNTSVILLE, Ala. – Two Alabama small businesses will share a \$30 million programmatic capacity Multiple Award Task Order Contract awarded by the U.S. Army Engineering and Support Center, Huntsville, July 30.

The contract was awarded to LTS Inc., of Huntsville, Ala., and GTCS Inc., of Athens, Ala.

The Center solicited all HUBZone firms, and two proposals were submitted.

The companies will perform work based on task orders they receive from the Huntsville Center. The period of performance is five years if all contract options are exercised.

The contract supports a wide variety of coordination and facilitation of efforts for master planning, requirements analysis, infrastructure studies, and programming documents for military installations, facilities, land, utilities, and related issues associated with internal “fence to fence” and external “military to civilian community” study efforts.

Huntsville Center is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers’ mandatory center of expertise for ranges and training lands.

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
