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## **Corps of Engineers Awards Energy Management Contract**

**HUNTSVILLE, Ala.** – The United States Army Corps of Engineers Engineering and Support Center, Huntsville awarded a task order contract award valued at up to \$122,521 to Williams Electric of Ft. Walton Beach, Fla., to provide a utility monitoring and control system for the United States Military Academy at West Point, N.Y.

This effort is follow-on work done previously at the academy by Williams Electric. The company's past performance with Huntsville Center helped lead to this additional work. The new work includes the development of equipment installation engineering plans, providing and installing hardware and software, developing a database system, testing and checking out the system, providing and installing data transmission equipment and performing ancillary work required to support the system.

The U.S. Army Engineering and Support Center, Huntsville, supports very specialized missions that require unique technical expertise in programs that are generally national or very broad in scope.
